Both of us were asked to take a newly redesigned World Team course called Gospel Foundations so that in the future we could facilitate the course. Sandra decided she was too busy as it was and would not be able to serve as a course facilitator in the future, so only Gary enrolled. The course was six weeks long, finishing in November. Gary enjoyed it and looks forward to being a facilitator for future students.

The congregation was surprised to find we were Spanish speaking Canadians.



Both of us continue to serve in our local church, involved in various ministries from leading Bible study to being on the church board. And ski season is here, so we will be with all our winter friends again. Gary will again be teaching skiing at Manning Park Resort so will be with a whole new group of young adults who are seasonal employees. Please ask the Lord to use us with all those with whom we spend time.

We will have a busy Christmas day, cooking for our entire family, as well as both Katrina's and Christian's parents. Perhaps Katrina's and Christian's siblings and spouses as well. We pray that you, too, will be able to be with family and friends to celebrate the birth of the Saviour.
